



Durbanville High School has produced a variety of provincial and national athletes in the last couple of years, all thanks to donors like you.

Sport and academic programs are structured to support one another, ensuring the best possible opportunities for our student-athletes. We are fortunate to have quality personnel and coaching staff to ensure student-athletes receive the necessary grades to further their studies.

The program has grown over recent years and in 2019 managed to recruit talented youngsters. This u14 group went undefeated at the Water-kloof netball tournament and bagged the CTHSN Super League title in the same season. The team boasted 2 SA indoor and 5 WP players.

Durbanville High School won the u19 CTHSN Super League title in 2018 & 2019. In 2022 Durbanville won 17 gold and 3 silver medals in the CTHSN Super league finals out of 20 Durbanville teams participating, including the First Team. The u14A team won the National u14 SA Top Schools title and the u17's finished in 5th place.

Durbanville went on to win the u15 and u17 Fast 5 Netball Tournament titles at Paarl Gimnasium.

Daiman Titus won silver at the 2022 SA Champs in the boys u19 100m.

Durbanville High School's top athletes set their sights on qualifying standards for studying at the top universities in the country as well as qualifying to study abroad at some of the USA's top universities.

Our student-athlete success STORIES

Durbanville High School's rugby program was bolsted when it entered a five-year deal with C2M Chartered Accountants in 2015. Through the Durbanville Alumni fund it received the necessary funding to recruit top coaches.

Durbanville prides itself in its development of players and was the case when it produced two WP Craven Week players who did not play any representative rugby at primary school in 2018.

The juniors have competed at the highest level and beat schools like Paarl Gymnasium, Paarl Boishaai, Paul Roos Gymnasium, Boland Landbou, HTS Drostdy, Monnas and Grey College in the 7's code. The u14's won the Peter Buttner 7's tournament in 2016 & 2017 beating Paarl Gymnasium and Paarl Boishaai in the finals. The juniors (u14-u16) have beaten Bishops, Garsfontein, Grey PE, HTS Middelburg, Oakdale, Outeniqua, Rondebosch, SACS and Wynberg in the 15-man code over the past few years.

2019 Saw Durbanville beating the likes of SACS and Stellenberg. 9 Seniors received bursaries to further their playing careers at universities.

Durbanville has delivered 25+ Western Province rugby players and various players making it into the SARU Elite Player Development Program over the past few years. In 2020 Durbanville had 4 SARU Elite Squad players.

In 2021 Durbanville ended the season in 7th place on the national rugby rankings. During 2022 Durbanville claimed the scalps of SACS and Helpmekaar. Durbanville also won the WP u18 7's title.

Through donor funding many aspiring young players have made their dream a reality and are studying through sport bursaries.

PATHWAYS PROGRAM

Durbanville High School has performed at the highest level at academics, sport and culture in recent years.

In an effort to attain and retain top student-athletes, Durbanville started the Pathways Program. The objective of the program is to provide talented, hardworking learners a pathway, through their sport, to tertiary education in the form of sport and academic bursaries. Durbanville High School's Sport & Marketing Department set-up partnerships with various universities and unions across South Africa as well as the USA providing student athletes with endless possibilities and opportunities.

While sport is the vehicle for this program, student-athletes' academics, are the determining factor. In order to be successful, student-athletes need to perform not only on the sports field, but also in the classroom. Durbanville High School provides student-athletes, in the Pathways Program, the opportunity to excel in the classroom. Student-athletes are monitored to ensure they achieve the necessary grades, which qualify them for tertiary studies. Student-athletes are helped by tutors and staff providing extra help classes, helping with learning disabilities, emotional wellbeing etc.

Universities and unions provide student-athletes with sport and academic bursaries at some of SA's leading universities such as University of Cape Town, Free State, North-West, Pretoria, Stellenbosch as well as the Western Cape. Universities in the USA are under NCAA standards and guidelines prohibit links and mentions of these universities as part of advertising. Durbanville has set-up partnerships with various universities for tertiary studies, should student-athletes qualify on their sporting achievements as well as their academic standards.

Thanks to donours, student-athletes are supported on the sports field and in the classroom.
